Website HIPAA / Notice of Privacy Practices Summary

Purpose of This Notice

This notice describes how medical information about you may be used and disclosed and how you can get access to this information. Please review it carefully.

Midland Medicine is committed to protecting the privacy of your health information. This website version is intended as a patient-friendly summary for online use. Midland Medicine may also maintain a separate full Notice of Privacy Practices for use in the practice, patient paperwork, or patient portal materials.

Our Responsibilities

Midland Medicine is required by law to maintain the privacy and security of protected health information (“PHI”), to provide you with notice of Midland Medicine’s legal duties and privacy practices with respect to PHI, and to notify affected individuals following a breach of unsecured PHI when required by law.

Midland Medicine will follow the duties and privacy practices described in the notice then in effect.

How Midland Medicine May Use and Disclose Your Health Information

Midland Medicine may use and disclose your health information for purposes such as:

Treatment

We may use and disclose your health information to provide, coordinate, or manage your healthcare and related services.

Payment

We may use and disclose your health information to bill and collect payment for the healthcare services you receive.

Healthcare Operations

We may use and disclose your health information for healthcare operations such as quality assessment, staff review, training, licensing, credentialing, business management, and other activities necessary to run Midland Medicine’s practice.

Other Permitted or Required Uses and Disclosures

Midland Medicine may also use or disclose health information when permitted or required by law, including for public health activities, health oversight activities, responding to court orders or lawful subpoenas, law enforcement purposes in limited circumstances, workers' compensation matters, and other uses authorized by applicable law.

Midland Medicine may share health information with business associates that perform services on Midland Medicine's behalf, provided those parties agree to safeguard the information as required by law.

Uses and Disclosures Requiring Authorization

Certain uses and disclosures of PHI require your written authorization, except where otherwise permitted or required by law. For example, authorization may be required for certain uses of psychotherapy notes, certain marketing communications, or the sale of PHI.

If you provide Midland Medicine with written authorization to use or disclose your information, you may revoke that authorization in writing at any time, except to the extent Midland Medicine has already acted in reliance on it.

Your Rights Regarding Your Health Information

Subject to applicable law, you may have the right to:

- request restrictions on certain uses and disclosures of your PHI;
- request confidential communications by alternative means or at alternative locations;
- inspect and obtain a copy of certain PHI Midland Medicine maintains about you;
- request an amendment to certain PHI if you believe it is incomplete or incorrect;
- receive an accounting of certain disclosures of your PHI;
- obtain a paper copy of Midland Medicine's Notice of Privacy Practices upon request; and
- file a complaint if you believe your privacy rights have been violated.

How to File a Complaint

If you believe your privacy rights have been violated, you may file a complaint with Midland Medicine or with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. Midland Medicine will not retaliate against you for filing a complaint.
